Health and Safety - Christmas Shut Down

Plant and equipment:

- ✓ Remove all keys and leave secure.
- ✓ Use plant as a barricade by positioning it in front of access points, on diesel bowsers and in front of containers. etc.
- ✓ Park large excavators either side by side or next to a shed/container to prevent access into the battery door.
- ✓ Some machines have vandal guards/shutters ensure these are fixed and secured.

Excavations:

- ✓ Where possible backfill all excavations to eliminate the risk.
- ✓ Alternatively- ensure all excavations are protected. Any excavations deeper than 1.2 meters requires heras panelling as protection, orange mesh will not suffice.
